Truterra[™] sustainability services offer a range of farmer-driven programs designed to help farmers unlock the potential value of every acre.


Truterra is introducing a number of region and crop-specific programs for Summer 2023. Each program is designed to meet farmers where they are on their sustainability journey, field-by-field, enabling them to try out a sustainability program without agreeing to a long-term commitment to a long-term contract. These programs could enable farmers who previously introduced conservation practices on their fields to participate in a sustainability program.

Farmers who participate in the 2023 Truterra[™] nitrogen management incentive program could potentially receive \$10/ acre while also building the baseline data required to potentially participate in future Truterra[™] programs.

THE BRIEF

- Available for eligible farmers. A farmer may be eligible if the farmer has corn fields in Illinois and has met the qualifying practice changes described below.
- Farmer reduces applied nitrogen by 20 lbs. per acre and/or adds an eligible enhanced efficiency fertilizer, as verified in accordance with Truterra's requirements.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE	Farmers with corn fields in Illinois with the qualifying practice changes described below
ENROLLMENT PERIOD	Open for enrollment August 1 – November 1, 2023
PAYMENT	\$10/acre
FIELD REQUIREMENTS	CROP: Corn PRACTICES: 20 lbs or more reduction in nitrogen applied per acre and/or addition of eligible enhanced efficiency fertilizer, including: - Nitrification inhibitors (nitrapyrin, pronitridine, DCD) - Urease inhibitors (NBPT, NPPT, Duromide) - Combination nitrification + urease inhibitors - Polymers and/or sulfur-coated urea All as applied in accordance with label instructions, and reductions as specified in accordance with Truterra's requirements* PRACTICE CHANGE YEAR: CY2023**
OTHER CRITERIA	Provide CY2023 data + 3 years historical baseline data* One-year contract Not participating in any other sustainability program for enrolled fields for CY2023

*The reduction is compared against the farmer's historical baseline, which is calculated by taking an average of the nitrogen fertilizer applied on that field to the 3 preceding corn crops.

** Eligible enhanced efficiency fertilizers are determined by the product's active ingredients. Please see your retailer for a list of eligible products.
