Add Fields

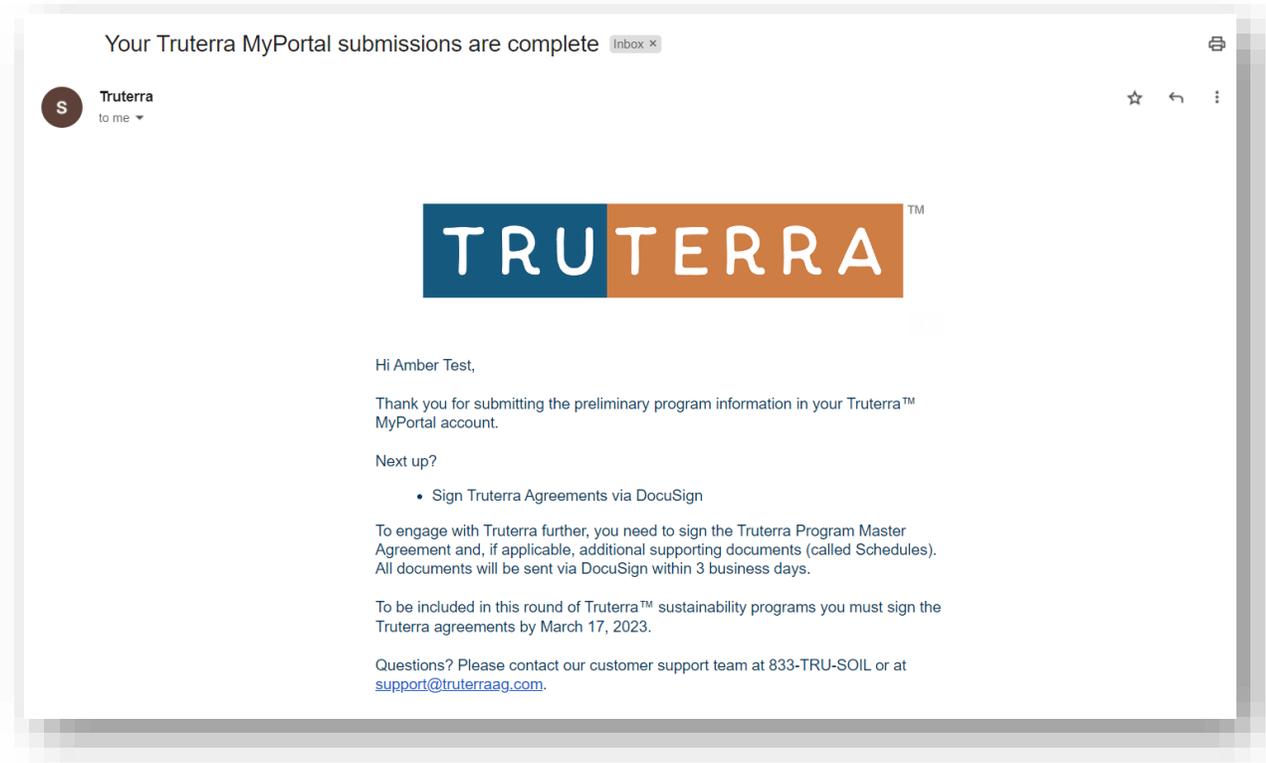
